

Ambassadors Football Holland Volunteer Agreement for Coaches

Voluntary, but not optional

You are willing to become a coach for Ambassadors Football Holland (hereinafter AFH). That's great. The board thanks you for that!

For being a coach at Ambassadors Football Holland, we find it important that you take note of our norms and values and other agreements and also agree to them by checking the box. These norms, values, and agreements are:

- By confirming this, you agree to adhere to the Biblical norms and values as well as the core values and code of conduct as formulated by Ambassadors Football Holland in its organization manual and actively promote them.
- You represent the vision of Ambassadors Football Holland and are responsible for the tasks you have undertaken.
- During activities of Ambassadors Football, coaches, players, or other participants must adhere to dress codes. During sports activities, clothing from Ambassadors Football is always worn in principle. It is not allowed to wear tight and/or short clothing. Sports shorts must be of minimal length up to halfway on the thigh. Low-cut shirts are also not allowed. This is further referred to as decent (sports) clothing. Even when representing the organization of Ambassadors Football Holland in a host family or while traveling, decent clothing must be worn. This requirement also applies to other activities, such as swimming, fitness, etc.
- You do not smoke, and during activities of Ambassadors Football, you do not consume alcohol (and if so, only outside Ambassadors Football activities and in strict moderation).
- By confirming this, you acknowledge that you have taken out health insurance and personal liability insurance for yourself, unless explicitly excluded by you in advance by making this known to the director of AFH. For foreign trips, it is additionally required to take out travel insurance (and possibly cancellation insurance).
- You may only use any personal data obtained for the performance of your activities as a coach for AFH and not for any other purpose. You will treat all personal data, and other confidential information received in the context of the activities, strictly confidentially and not show, provide, or otherwise make it available to third parties (including your own family members or other members or volunteers of AFH), unless the board of AFH has expressly given written permission for this.
